# Introducing the 7 Week Challenge

The **7 Week Challenge (7WC)** is a series of events hosted by Vincent Massey's Computer Science Club in partnership with Canada's oldest and largest high school hackathon, MasseyHacks. The 7WC is an extension of MasseyHacks' goal to inspire innovation, the development of big ideas, and a passion for learning. This compilation of free virtual events will take place over the course of 7 weeks, starting on **April 24th, 2021**.

Each week will feature a new topic as well as a diverse spectrum of workshops, activities, and challenges for students to further apply their knowledge. Topics will range from cybersecurity and algorithmic programming to web, game, and hardware development, thus giving students a better idea of what the world of computer science and technology looks like. The 7WC will conclude with **MasseyHacks VII**, a 36-hour virtual hackathon jam-packed with countless opportunities for hackers to show off what they learned. We anticipate that the 7WC (including MasseyHacks VII) will bring in **over 250** students from all over the world.

## Learnathon

This weekend acts as a kick-off and covers a basic yet diverse range of topics that will leave students excited for what is to come.



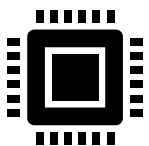
## Algorithms

This week will introduce participants to the theoretical implementations of algorithmic programming and encourage them to take part in various beginner-friendly programming contests.



## Game Jam

This event will start off by guiding students through simple game development using Unity3D, leading into the 2-week long Game Jam, which allows participants to apply and build on what they learned.



## Hardware

This week focuses on basic hardware development with Arduino and TinkerCAD. Participants will be provided with materials in advance.



## Web Development

This week introduces participants to web development and provides the necessary groundwork to create a simple static website.



## Cryptography

This week focuses on problem solving, encryption, and cybersecurity, culminating in the infamous Hackenger Hunt, which will be run in partnership with MasseyHacks.
